This schedule is tentative. If the number of entries causes the judge's working time to exceed USEF allowable limits, the BLM Finals classes may be scheduled on different days Than indicated above; this includes the possibility of Thursday Finals classes. Competitors MUST check their times on the internet and in their show packet upon arrival at the show. Finals classes may be held at night under lights.

2008 CBLM Championship Finals Rules

The tests must be ridden from memory and without whips.

- During the entire Finals competition, no horse entered in a CBLM Final may be ridden by anyone other than the rider entered in the Final on that horse.
 - (Exception: grooms riding on a loose rein).
- A horse/rider team may compete at one level only at the Finals at the USEF levels; a horse may compete at only one USEF-level Final but may compete in an adjacent-level freestyle Final. A horse/rider team may compete at two

adjacent FEI levels at the Finals but not in both Fourth Level and Prix St. Georges. Training Level Division A and First Level Division A are limited to qualified riders who have not competed above Second Level at an USEF - licensed show.

Second Level Division A, Third Level Division A are limited to qualified riders

who have not competed at or above the FEI Prix St. Georges level or in any of the FEI Young Rider levels at an USEF- licensed show.

Fourth Level Division A is limited to qualified riders who have not competed at or above the FEI Intermediaire I level at an USEF- licensed show.

Prix St Georges Division A is limited to qualified riders who have not competed at or above the FEI Intermediaire II level at an USEF licensed show.

- If four or more Junior/Young Riders enter at any one level above First Level, separate Finals classes will be held for these entries on Saturday or Sunday.
- Award ceremonies for BLM Finals Classes will take place the day of the class. Horse and rider must be present; rider must be mounted in full attire. Failure to be present and properly attired may eliminate the official score and placing, and the next highest score may move up in placing.

The closing date for this show is September 22, 2008. The last weekend to qualify is September 20-21, 2008. Qualifying entries from this last weekend should be FedEx or UPS overnighted to the secretary!

The results of BLM Qualifying classes will be used to qualify horse/rider combinations for the Finals of the 2008 Colonel Bengt Ljungquist Memorial Championship Finals. For riders who are members at the time of this show of either CAMDA, CDA, CDCTA, DVCTA, ECRDA, ESDCTA, GSDA, HDS, IEO, LVDA, MDA, NCDCTA, OCDA, OVCTA, PVDA, SCDCTA, VADA, OR WPDA.

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICA-TIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

This show will be conducted and judged in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the current USEF Rule Book. USEF members must provide proof of current membership (USEF card or copy thereof) either with the entry form or when checking in at show office. Membership affidavit fee is \$5.

LEVELS: USEF Training Level through FEI Grand Prix; USDF & FEI Musical Freestyle; including 2008 CBLM Finals classes; 2009 NAJRYC Qualifying, BLM Qualifying, & GAIG Qualifying classes; USDF Pas de Deux.

AWARDS: Trophy & six ribbons in each class. High percentage awards (Finals scores will be excluded): Overall, SR Overall, JR Overall, YR Overall, AA Overall, Training, First, Second, Third, Fourth Levels & FEI Levels combined, Freestyle combined (Freestyle scores are excluded in other high percentage awards). Other HS awards may be offered.

BLM Championship Finals: Ribbons awarded to eighth place; Training and First level will be pinned through 10th place. Formal award presentations to be scheduled at lunch break, dinner break and after evening classes and riders are required to attend the ceremony properly attired and mounted to receive their awards in the Coliseum. In each of the BLM FINALS CLASSES, a separate trophy and eight ribbons will be awarded for SENIOR RIDERS and JUNIOR/YOUNG RIDERS for each class in which at least four Junior/Young Riders compete. At least \$5,000 in prize money will be awarded in the BLM Open Finals classes. USEF rules pertaining to ties will be followed, Prize Money will be split. Prize Money will be awarded Within 30 days of the competition.

Three scores will be used to determine the MEAN score and placings 1 - 6 will be presented on Sunday, 10/26 (if all the scores have been turned in), otherwise, they will be sent to the riders & posted on the website. Divisions: USDF Musical Freestyle ($1^{st} - 4^{th}$) and FEI Musical Freestyle (YR, Int. 1 & GP).

Mary Beth McLean Memorial Perpetual Trophy: This award remembers FEI rider Mary Beth McLean. The winner is determined by totaling the PSG & Int. 1 BLM finals scores, and they will receive a small trophy and their name will be engraved on the large trophy.

ENTRIES: Entries accepted by the date received by the secretary. You MUST use the 2008 Entry blank! Telephone entries will not be accepted. All entries (competing & non-competing) *MUST* include a valid Coggins test (though 10/26/08) or the entry WILL BE RETURNED. Entries in Musical Freestyle classes (except YR Freestyle) <u>MUST</u> be accompanied by a photocopy of a test verifying eligibility to enter the class (i.e. 58% at the highest test of the declared freestyle level or any test of a higher level from an USEF recognized show. JR/YR riders are reminded to include their birth date or their entries will be returned; Junior riders CAN NOT sign as Rider or Trainer, please have your parent or guardian sign.

- *Freestyles: Rider must present a good quality CD and/or tape to the Secretary by 8 AM the day of the class. There will be a sound check on Thursday, 10/18, from 5 - 7 PM and at other TBD times during the competition, near the lunch breaks in Ring 1.
- MEMBERSHIP AFFIDAVIT FEE: If a participant does not have their USEF membership card (or a copy), they must sign an affidavit and pay the \$5 fee, or if a non-member pay the \$20 nonmember fee and applicable division fee. Individuals who have applied to USEF for membership within 30 days prior to the show may apply to USEF for a refund of the \$5 affidavit fee. See Entry Form for information on the USEF Breed/Discipline Fee.
- FEI Junior & Young Riders: FEI Junior & Young Rider classes are conducted under FEI rules. Entrants are encouraged to confirm the current USEF qualifying procedures. FEI saddlery is require and tests must be ridden for memory. Horses in NAJRYC classes at this competition may not be schooled by anyone other than the competitor during the 4 days preceding this first day of this competition, as well as during the duration of the event; however, as groom mounted in the saddle may walk the horse on a long rein, and lunging and assistance from the ground by someone other than the competitor is permitted. These entries do NOT require FEI passports.

TIMES: Please DO NOT include post card or envelope; times will be ONLY posted on the Competition website. Remember to check IN your packet when your check in for any changes.

STABLING: \$150.00 Wednesday night through Saturday night and any portion thereof; \$45.00 for any consecutive 24 hr period & you are LIMITED to two (2) 24 hr periods and stable with requests WILL not be considered. Permanent stabling on grounds (concrete walls, sliding doors, under roof). NO Initial bedding. Bedding & hay are available for purchase from the Horse Center Stable Office. Stabling will NOT be posted! Please check in at the Stabling Office upon arrival to receive your stable assignments.

Normal arrival time is 12 noon the day preceding the horse show (10/22). Earlier arrivals must be coordinated with stable manager at least two weeks in advance. Stabling and security fees may apply. Stabling assignments **CAN NOT** be changed without permission of the **Stable Manager**. Stabling request changes will be honored until 10/3/08, please make your stabling arrangements early! After this date, there is NO guarantee that you will be stabled with a certain group.

Layover Policy -- All stalls must be vacated by noon of Monday. Hourly security charges shall remain in effect from the close of the show, until the last horse has left the grounds. NON COMPETING HORSES: Any horse not competing must fill out an Entry Form (all 3 signatures), including a current Coggins test, the \$35 non competing fee, \$25 Office fee and the applicable stable fees. Due to the large number of competing horses, these horses may be restricted in their ring time. COMPETITOR PARTIES: Wine & Cheese Party; Doggy Costume Class-> days TBA at the show DOGS: Must be tied at or in stalls and walked on a leash at all times!

SHOW OFFICE: Hours: 7 AM – 8 PM. Phone #: 540-464-2950 (starting Wed at noon). ARENAS: Competition: 2 Indoor coliseums; outdoor Grand Stand with lights; 3 or 4 all weather surface footing. RECOGNITION: United States Equestrian Federation, United Stated Dressage Federation, Virginia Dressage Association.

OTHER:

Management reserves the right to add or divide classes, add or substitute judges, or make any changes required by circumstances.

Riders may substitute horses once they have entered only in the classes they were entered and a new entry form will be required.

Farrier, Veterinarian, and Paramedic will be on grounds. All emergency numbers will be posted in the Show Office and near the pay phones.

Numbers must be worn at all time when the horse is out of their stall.

Proper headgear must be worn at all times when on horseback.

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license that allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

HOLD HARMLESS CLAUSE:

HOLD HARMLESS CLAUSE: Understanding that horse sports may be hazardous and dangerous, even leading to permanent injury or death, each owner, rider, spectator, and other participant assumes any and all risk of loss or injury and agrees to hold harmless, regardless of negligent acts or omissions, the Virginia Dressage Association, the Virginia Horse Center, the show management, show committee, and all show personnel. It is further understood that each participating rider, trainer, owner, their heirs and assigns agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless USDF, USEF, its instructors, officers, directors, agents and volunteers from and against any and all loss, liability or damage arising from or because of, or in connection with, participation in the competition or related activities.
