WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

LEVELS: USEF Training level through FEI Grand Prix including FEI Para-Equestrian, USDF, FEI, FEI PE Musical Freestyle, including 2010 GAIG & BLM Qualifiers, USDF Materiale, USDF Introductory, USEF & FEI Eventing, USEF Opportunity classes, USDF Region 1 Adult Team day 2 tests.

AWARDS: Trophy & six ribbons in each class. High Score Awards: Intro; Training - Fourth Levels; FEI; (MFS, Para-Eq, Eventing, Opportunity tests not included). At this show, there will be awarded to riders who competed in both Twin shows: Overall High Score; High Score for Intro; Training - Fourth; FEI; (MFS, Intro, Opportunity, FEI Para-Eq, Eventing tests not included).

USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal: Awards from class 223, Second Level Test 3.

SUNDAY SPECIAL: Benefit Classes - Adult Amateur Extravaganza (ATE) :

- > Teams of 2 AA riders, must compete in the same test & level
- > Teams must be declared on entry form
- > 2 rides must be from either classes Tr-1, First 1, Second 1, Third 1, Fourth 1, or PSG.
- > Prizes for each level's First place team with ribbons through 3rd place
- > Team nomination fee: \$30.
- > ^Proceeds to go to the Charlottesville Police Department Foundation, to support the Canine Unit.

ENTRIES: Entries accepted by the **date received by the secretary. You MUST use the 2010 Entry form!** Make all checks payable to: **VADA-CH, Inc.** Telephone entries are NOT accepted.

All entries (competing & non-competing) MUST include a valid Negative Coggins test (through 9/5/10) or the entry **WILL BE RETURNED.** Entry form must be signed by: rider, owner, trainer (the responsible person for the horse during the show), MINORS may not sign for Rider or Trainer, please have a parent/guardian sign. Please include a valid, **LEGIBLE** email address - all correspondence will be by email.

Bounced Check Policy: Entry will be removed from the schedule, charged the bounced check fee and placed on the Wait List until a money order or certified check is received by the Entry Secretary.

All entries (competing & non-competing horses) must include USEF & USDF numbers with proof (Master verification sheet preferred) and ALL the required signatures in accordance with USEF rules.

Full Refund minus \$20.00 Office fee if the Entry Secretary is notified on or before 8/13/10. **NO REFUNDS AFTER THE CLOSING DATE, including the cancellation of classes due to inclement weather.** Entry confirmation will be EMAILED to each competitor upon processing of entry. Please check this for any errors. If you have any questions or did not receive this confirmation, contact the Secretary immediately. You must provide an emergency contact & phone # for the RIDER during the show and if stabled, an emergency contact & phone # must be written on the stall card for each stabled horse.

* All riders must wear appropriate headgear when mounted.

* **FREESTYLE** riders must present a good quality CD (& backup) to the Secretary by 10 AM the day of the class. The sound system will be available for testing, to be announced at show.

TIMES: Will be available on www.VADACH.org one week before the competition. They will **NOT BE MAILED.**

STABLING: No initial bedding. Pre-orders are encouraged. Permanent stalls (10' x 10') with half doors, stallions may need stall guards for doors. Security 9 pm - 6 am. Please note on entry if you are entering the VADA-CH Twin I show on 9/4/10.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: GR901.29 Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

ARENAS: Numerous outdoor sand/bluestone arenas, 20m x 60m. USDF Intro & applicable USEF Eventing tests may be held in the 20m x 40m arena. Warm-up & lunging: Sand/bluestone. All arenas will be dragged and watered as needed throughout the show.

FOOD: Available on the grounds. Commonwealth Park allows and has numerous pretty areas for cook-outs, so please bring your equipment!

MEDICAL WASTE: All medical waste (needles, syringes, etc) must NOT be discarded in stalls, manure pits, garbage cans or on the ground. All medical waste must be placed in appropriate containers located in each barn.

DIRECTIONS: HITS Commonwealth Park is located on Route 522, 3.5 miles south of the junction with Route 3 in Culpeper.

From South: US 29 north to Exit US 522/Rt 3 towards Mineral & Fredericksburg. Turn Right on US 522/Rt 3, follow 3.5 miles to US 522. Turn RIGHT on Rt 522. Follow and turn LEFT into Commonwealth Park. You will see the showgrounds on the left, before you see the entrance.

From North: US 29 south to Exit US 522/Rt 3. Turn LEFT at light and then follow as above.
